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## -TOOLS REQUIRED-

Metric Socket Set • Combination Wrench Set • Metric Allen Wrench Set

## -REMOVAL-

- 1. Remove seat.
- 2. Disconnect turn signal wires.
- 3. Remove the (4) bolts securing the stock fender assembly from under the passenger seat.
- 4. Carefully remove stock fender assembly.
- 5. Remove stock license plate light bulb from stock fender assembly.
- 6. Remove turn signals and turn signal shim from the stock fender assembly as they will be used with the Yoshimura Fender Eliminator Kit.
- 7. Cut the stock license plate light wire 3" from the license plate light bulb.

### -INSTALLATION-

- 1. Install (12120-FEBKT) fender eliminator bracket using the four stock bolts and provided (8MMNUT) flange nut. See diagram for proper orientation.
- 2. Install (070BG-LH-K1) LED license plate light onto (12200-FEBKT) license plate bracket using the two (M4x6BHS) screws as shown in the parts diagram.
- 3. Install (12200-FEBKT) license plate bracket onto (12120-FEBKT) fender eliminator bracket using the two (M6X10BHS) screws.
- If using stock exhaust, follow instructions for a). If using Yoshimura exhaust, follow instructions for b).

IMPORTANT: Failure to install the stock turn signals in the correct location could lead to permanent damage of turn signal and/or muffler.

Stock Exhaust

a) Install stock turn signals onto (12120-FEBKT) fender eliminator bracket using the stock turn signal shim and stock turn signal securing nut.

Yoshimura Exhaust

- b) Install stock turn signals onto (12120-TSBKT-L) and (12120-TSBKT-R) turn signal brackets using the stock turn signal shim and stock turn signal securing nut.
- 5. Install (070BG-LPF) license plate frame and license plate to (12200-FEBKT) license plate bracket using the hardware provided in the kit. See diagram for proper orientation and order of hardware. If using turn signal brackets, install as shown on the parts diagram.
- 6. Using the connectors provided in the kit, connect the Yoshimura Fender Eliminator wires to the stock license plate light wires as follows: Red wire goes to Green wire; Black wire goes to Yellow wire.
  - A) Strip the stock fender light wires ends ¼" ½" and insert into BN-SSS-22-18, butt connectors provided in the kit.
  - B) Center the spliced wire ends in the middle and using a heat gun or lighter, apply heat evenly on the outer edges of the butt connector to shrink and hold wires in place.

- C) Making sure that the stripped ends are centered, heat the center of the butt connector evenly until the solder begins to liquify.
- D) Allow to cool completely and tug both ends of the wires to verify that connection is secured.

- 7. Route wires through hole in bracket and underneath the seat. Reconnect turn signal and license plate light wires.
- 8. Re-install passenger seat.
- 9. Check for function of license plate light and turn signals and that all brackets and components are secure prior to riding.
